1 Scribal Activity

1.1 General

During the reporting period a number of records were imported from the Canon database, updating scribes assignments to the end of April 2014, increasing the overall number of assignments to be completed.

During May – 24 records – updated until the end of April

These scrolls were given the status "Recently Imported" until it could be established whether or not the recipients have registered armoury. These were then updated with "on hold" or "available" categories.

It should be noted that following the database updates that some of the overdue assignments returned to "available" pool, following greater ease of follow-up and administration.

1.2 Lochac Scroll Challenge

Following the announcement of the Lochac Scroll Challenge interest in scribing, particularly illumination, continues to be encouraging with a number of new and interested scribes requesting assignments. Typical requests involve the new scribe requesting the illumination only while existing / more experienced scribes take on the calligraphy.

2 Internet

The operation of the College is facilitated by a number of electronic means. Comments below.

2.1 Online Database

The reporting period has seen a "clean-up" of the scribes held in the database. This includes:

- removal of duplicate scribes where spelling errors have seen the same scribe represented more than once
- assignment of geography to over 100 scribes, leaving only two scribes of an unassigned location (who have no outstanding scrolls and have been inactive for many years)

2.2 Scribes' Flicker Site

The Scribes' Flicker site was last updated in August 2014. This site will be updated as more assignments are given out to the recipients.
