1 Scribal Activity

During December, 68 records were imported from the Canon database, updating scribes assignments to the end of November 2013, increasing the overall number of assignments to be completed. These scrolls were given the status "Recently Imported" until it could be established whether or not the recipients have registered armoury.

There are new Wardens in place in Polit, Stormhold and Innilgard, none of whom have been required to report due to only having recently stepped up.

1.2 Lochac Scroll Challenge

Following the announcement of the Scribes' Online Database (please see below) a Challenge was issued to the populace of Lochac, pertaining to those "who had ever received a scroll or hoped to receive a scroll" to participate in the completion of at least one AoA scroll in order to reduce the backlog that has increased over recent reigns.

Interest has been encouraging with a number of new scribes coming forward volunteering to take part in this challenge, particularly the illumination component.

1.3 Beginners' Kits

The operation of the College is facilitated by a number of electronic means. Comments below.

2.1 Online Database

Following testing by the Anealan & Mordenvalian Wardens, Warden access has been rolled out to all of the current Wardens, including those who have only recently been appointed. Feedback to date has been limited but positive.

An announcement was made on the Scribes' and Announce list in order to notify the populace that the online database was ready for public access. Interest has been encouraging with over 2,000 unique visitors and over 66,000 total visits in recent months. Given that Australia currently has 1269 current members and New Zealand has 165 current members, totalling 1434 current members, I find this is indicative of a great deal of passive interest in how the Kingdom's scrolls are progressing.

Following this announcement a number of mistakes in the data reported were reported by the populace, which have either been addressed or are in the process of being addressed. Unfortunately, some of these mistakes point to scrolls being lost at some point prior to reaching the recipient.

2.2 Scribes' Mailing List

The mailing list was experiencing problems in changing moderators and approving pending requests at the time of the previous report. This issue has been resolved with assistance Diego, of the Kingdom Masonry Team.
