6 Kingdom Seneschal's report The Kingdom has a new web wright, Sorle Maknicoll. Masonry Deputy is still in the application phase, we have two current candidates. The Keeper of Regalia position has been advertised. Rowany has a new Seneschal, Ykaterina Vaginavich Bychkov (Katya Ghirardello), to step up in April next year. Stowe, Southron Gaard, and Ynys Fawr are currently seeking a new Seneschal.

> The Barony of Stormhold have been successful in their bid to host Spring Crown Tournament in September 2025. There is currently a bid being assessed for Spring Coronation 2025 by River Haven.

> I have separately emailed regarding a discussion with Seneschals about proposed WWC and police checks for officers. The WWC check suggestion was not seen as necessary. Most officers have little interaction with children and the Seneschals did not see the value. There was also little interest in have all officers perform a police check. Roles such as A&S and Heralds did not see why they should perform this. Alternatively there was a definite acceptance of a police check for Seneschals and Reeves. I still have concerns about a possible reduction in candidates if we add extra requirements, but the Seneschals themselves could see a reason for this.

I have asked Jeremy to join this meeting to discuss the next steps for the Alternate Crown process. How the Board can implement a test tourney.

SCANZ committee requested that the position of Deputy Exchequer for New Zealand be advertised. This has been done and there have been no applicants.

I have reached out to other Kingdoms to get copies of their DEI documentation as a basis for Lochac DEI officers. That's a work in progress.
